Duty station: Union Level, Department of Rural Development, Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock and Irrigation, with frequent travel to townships.

Contract Type: A one-year (12 months) time base contract, full time and renewable subject to annual performance review and project need.

Introduction

The objectives of the National Community Driven Development Project (NCDDP) is

- To enable rural communities to benefit from improved local infrastructure and services through a people-centered approach.
- To enhance the Government's capacity to respond promptly and effectively to an eligible crisis or emergency.
- To enable the government to deliver visible results of reform at the community level.
- Help to foster a constructive relationship between government and communities.

With a rapid scaling up of the project, building up training capacities to township TFs and DRD infrastructure team is critical. In this context, DRD intends to apply parts of the proceeds for hiring of 6 local Infrastructure/Safeguard Assistant to be base at Union CDD Secretary Office with frequently visits to the project townships.

Main Objective of the Position.

Support Union level DRD in conducting training of NCDDP, DRD and Technical Facilitation Staff (TFs) at regional and township level and assist in quality management of sub project infrastructure.

Description of duties and responsibilities:

The National Infrastructure/ Safeguard Assistants will be a member of the Union Infrastructure team, based at DRD Office, Nay Pyi Taw and travelling to NCDDP target township areas. They will;

- Under supervision of Union Project Infrastructure Unit, conduct technical trainings of Regional DRD and Township DRD and Township Technical Facilitators in ;
 - Relevant NCDDP operational procedures,
 - DRD Quality Standards and Standard Designs and specifications,

- NCDDP Environmental Code of Practice (ECOP),
- Environmental and Social Safeguards,
- Environmental Management Plans,
- Operation and Maintenance,
- Rural Infrastructure Quality Management (Sub-project Quality Checklists)
- Disaster Risk Management
- Assist when required with Union level technical supervision of sub-projects to develop a sound understanding of NCDDP sub-project technical requirements.
- Advise NCDDP on technical quality issues and make recommended changes in training materials and procedures as required.
- Contribute technical expertise to the DRD in areas where the Training Engineer has specific skills or experience relevant to NCDDP.
- Become very familiar with all key project documents, in particular the Operations Manual, ECOP, Standard designs, Specifications and bills of quantities, and the Engineering/Technical design and supervision forms and procedures.
- Work closely with the training unit of NCDDP to develop and improve training materials and methods.
- Accomplish other tasks as requested, according to project's needs.

Qualifications and experiences

- Bachelor degree in Civil engineering (**BE-Civil**)
- At least 4 years of experience in infrastructure design implementation and supervision.
- At least 2 years of experience in participatory community development, technical training and training of trainers, or 1 year of experience in participatory community development, technical training and training of trainers combined with NCDDP project experience.
- Show sensitivity towards gender and ethnic issues found in the rural areas and a willingness to travel to and in townships for extended periods of time.
- Knowledge and experience of government and foreign aid project operations.
- Good command of spoken and written English
- Good computer skills including MS. Office. Knowledge of CAD software is highly desirable.
- Willingness to transfer skills.

Preferable:

- Prior experience with NCDDP is desirable.
- Strong ethical commitment to impartiality, integrity and transparency
- Possess strong team building capacity, good communication and social skills and ability to coordinate with local people.
- Ability to work independently, within the framework of the project's requirements.
